LIBRARY CARDS

Henderson County residents and those who work, own property, or attend school in the county can acquire a library card at no charge by presenting proper identification, a picture ID with a current address. A parent or guardian must be present for a child under 14 to be issued a library card.

Replacement fee for a lost card is \$2.

A non-resident may purchase a card for \$20 per year.

Your Henderson County card can be used at any library in the NC Cardinal consortium.

You must bring your card with you to check out items or use library computers.

OVERDUE FINES

Interlibrary Loans	50 cents	\$10 per item

Patrons must pay replacement costs for items lost or damaged enough to be withdrawn from the collection. The library sends up to three notices when items are overdue. **Accounts with lost materials exceeding \$25 will be sent to a collection agency if not settled. When fines and fees exceed \$25, borrowing privileges are also suspended.**

COMPUTER SERVICES

All library branches have Wi Fi and computers with Microsoft Office 2010 applications and internet access.

Using your library card you may log in for up to 3 hours per day. Most locations have both 1 hour workstations and express 15 minute workstations.

Patrons without a library card in hand may purchase a guest pass for \$1. The guest pass may be used for up to 3 hours per day and is valid for a week at the branch where it was purchased.
